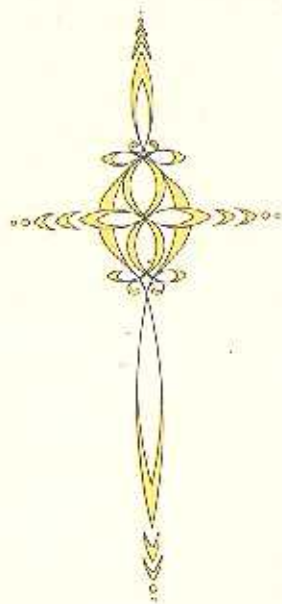

PRESS NOTES

Robert Drummond, Former Honolulu, Dies in California

A former Honolulu resident, Robert Drummond, died at his home in Beaumont, Calif., last Thursday morning, according to word received here Monday.

Mr. Drummond was born in Belfast, Ireland, on May 17, 1895. He left Ireland in 1907 for Canada and later moved to California.

During World War I he served with the Royal Engineers and came to Honolulu in 1924 to work for Honolulu Iron Works. He later was employed with the army air depot.

At the start of World War II he was transferred to Kaneohe naval air station. He retired in 1947 and since 1948 he and Mrs. Drummond have made their home in California.

He is survived by his widow, the former Norine Overman of Honolulu, a daughter, one grandchild, a brother and two sisters in Canada.

Mrs. Drummond is the daughter of Mrs. Jessie M. Overman, 1532 Liholilo St., who left Friday for the mainland to be with her daughter.
